





























Four Seasons Hotel Hangzhou at Hangzhou Center

Hangzhou, China

Located in the heart of Hangzhou's vibrant urban core, the Four Seasons Hotel anchors the landmark Hangzhou Center—a 150,000-square-meter mixed-use development composed of two elegant towers. The 214-key hotel bridges modern urban life and the city's spiritual heritage, positioned between the Qiantang River and the historic West Lake.

Though part of a large-scale development, the hotel is conceived as a sanctuary within the city. A private arrival sequence, wrapped in lush landscaping and a refined granite-and-glass façade, transitions guests into a world of quiet luxury. The hotel's architectural language is defined by subtle elegance: a pinwheel tower form maximizes light, views and efficiency, offering column-free corners and expansive glazing that float above the skyline.

Central to the experience are the elevated gardens—verdant landscapes that redefine urban hospitality. The Level 8 Garden, shared with retail and office users, integrates a secluded Chinese restaurant garden, while the exclusive Level 10 Sky Garden offers over 4,700 square meters of landscaped outdoor rooms for reflection, dining and celebration. These spaces act as natural extensions of the hotel's interiors, where materials, lighting and framed views evoke a sense of calm immersion.

The hotel's interiors maintain a constant dialogue with nature. Guestrooms—ranging from 51.5 to 63 square meters—offer panoramic views to the river or West Lake, reinforcing a deep connection to place. Rooftop lounges and a garden terrace provide a final retreat above the city.

Sustainability strategies include stormwater-capturing gardens, operable windows for ventilation, and high-performance, low-reflectivity glazing.
